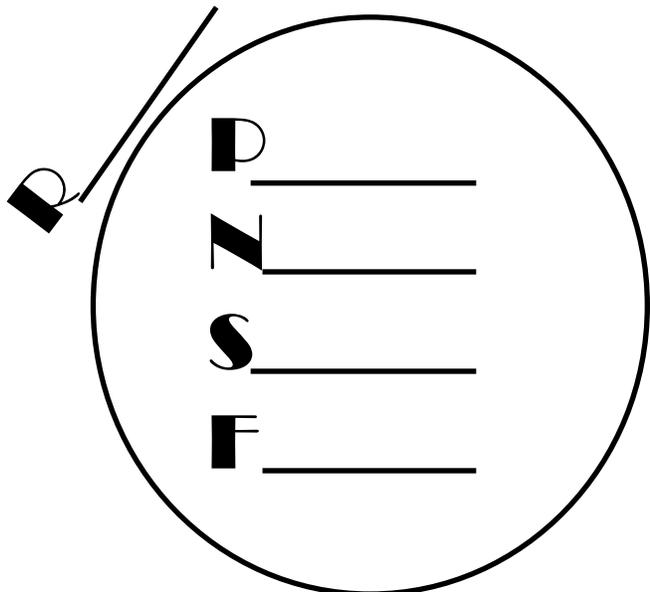

- Being appreciated

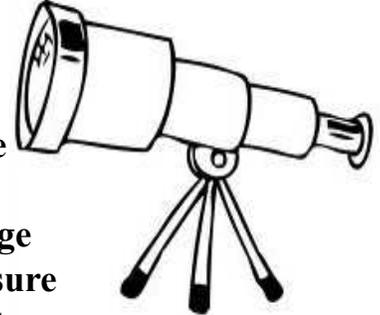
Areas of Improvement

- Getting off track

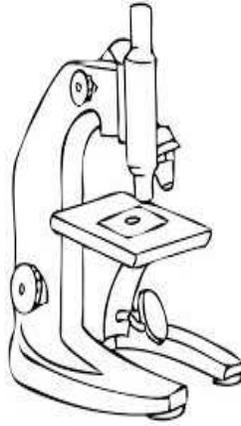
Motivating Factors

- Taking action

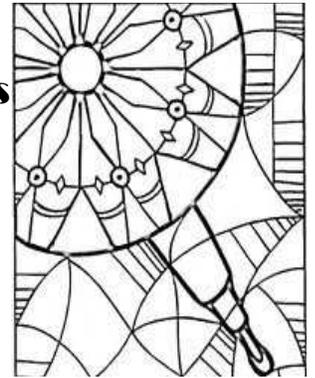
Motivating Factors
